The seniors should be finished with their products in preparation for final product grading next week. One mandatory component they must complete by tomorrow, Jan. 27 is the Final Mentor Approval. They must meet with their Mentor to go over their Original Letter of Intent, & then show the Mentor evidence of all the work they've completed. The Mentor will then evaluate the evidence the senior presents, & decide if he/she can 1) wholeheartedly support, 2) support with some reservations, or 3) not support their completed product. The Mentor's evaluation will be submitted tomorrow, Fri, Jan. 27 by 2pm, but will not be the final say whether the Senior Project Passes or goes into Recovery.

● **Starting Wed, Feb. 15 is Foodland's Shop for Higher Education 2017 - Scholarship Awarded!**

The SFHE Program will run for 6 weeks from Wed, Feb. 15th through Tue, March 28, 2017. The Program is open to all public & private high schools statewide. Maika'i Members must designate their favorite high school(s). Maika'i Members earn Maika'i Points for themselves & their designated school(s) during the 6 weeks of the program. The more Maika'i Points a school earns, the more scholarships it will receive!

(100) \$2,000 scholarships will be awarded based on a ranking system. Foodland will rank schools based on the number of Maika'i Points earned in the program.



Ranking system: Top (5) schools will receive (5) \$2,000 scholarships each. Next (10) schools will receive (3) \$2,000 scholarships each. Next (10) schools will receive (2) \$2,000 scholarships each. ...& so on till all (100) scholarships are awarded!

We are grateful to our Ohana & Kekaulike Complex Schools (Paia, Kula, Pukalani, Haiku, Makawao & Kalama), **& Community** for their support. KKHS has ranked in the top (5) schools or the next (10) schools yearly. It's a tough competition as these scholarships are greatly desired. (FYI: The scholarships are not based on financial need.) **The first week is so important.** Those schools ranked #1 to #7 in the first week, almost always keep their rank for the whole 6 weeks!
