• **Tue, Feb. 28: ACT Testing in Hawaii for Grades 9-11:**

Hawaii Dept. of Education students in grades 9, 10 & 11, will be tested on Tue, Feb. 28. All 9th and 10th grade students will be taking the ACT Aspire Test. All 11th grade students will be taking the actual ACT. Scores can be used for college admission.

The ACT is designed to assess what high school students have learned in school. The multiple-choice tests cover four skill areas: English, mathematics, reading, & science. The optional Writing Test measures skill in planning & writing a short essay. ACT results are accepted by virtually all U.S. colleges & universities.

Our seniors may choose to attend the **Class of 2017 Luau from 8am-1:30pm**. Students who do not want to attend luau can come to school and will be housed in the chorus room for the day.
