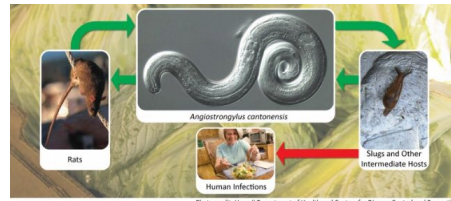


● **“Powerful Tools for Grandparents Raising Grandchildren” starts Fri, April 28, 2017:**
