 - Signs & balloons should be left in vehicles or on the side fence. (KKHS will not be responsible for any damaged or missing articles.)
 - Use of air horns & streamers are strictly prohibited & will be confiscated, &/or may result in the removal of any person observed utilizing them.
 - Also, no food will be sold at the concession.
 - Lei sellers are not permitted.

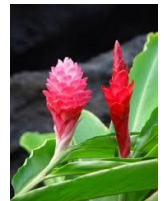
● **Na Ali'i Store's Last 2 Wednesdays< May 17 & 24:**
