Handicapped Drop Off & Parking

- Enter through Haleakala Highway entrance. Drive through lower firelane.
- Drop off handicap or elderly passengers in front of the stadium ticket booth. (A few chairs will be there for those needing to sit & wait)
- Drive through firelane & park by tennis courts
- At the End of Commencement,
 Handicap Pick-Up: Note: Due to heavy
 pedestrian traffic, wait at least 20 minutes
 after ceremony (lei giving) has been
 completed.
- Stadium Firelane will be ONE-WAY, from tennis courts to bandroom (Haleakala Hwy) Drivers may pick up waiting passengers in front of ticket office
- Parking on our KKHS campus & at Jesus Is Alive Church is FREE.
