The deadline for \*Technology Responsible Use Form (TRUF) is Wed, Aug. 31. Students that have not turned in their signed TRUFs will have their KKHS Google account suspended AND will not able to use any Dept. Of Education device/service. Then students will be unable to do any work requiring the use of computers/internet services.
