• Deadline: Th, Sept. 1st to Register for the October 1st SAT or Subject Exams. Cost is \$45 for SAT only & \$57 for SAT with essay. Students on Free & Reduced lunch may get a fee waiver from Mrs. Gomer in room F-204. <u>Deadline: Th, Sept. 1</u>. Late registration goes through Sept. 20, & costs an additional \$28. Fee waivers can be used for late registration with no additional fee. Register at <u>collegeboard.org</u> & pay on-line with a credit card. **Our school code is 120218**. • Register for PSAT to be Held Wed, Oct. 19th at KKHS: Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test will be held on Wed., Oct. 19. Exam is \$15 for all students. <u>There is no cost to 11th graders who qualify for free or reduced lunch</u>. Students should see college & career

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counselor, Mrs. Gomer, in F-204 to sign-up during recess, lunch or after school. **Deadline: Sept 22.** Students who take the PSAT/NMSQT will receive free access to My College Quickstart, an online college & career planning tool. <u>11th graders</u> who score very high on their PSAT could become National Merit Scholar finalists, which means scholarship opportunities! Students need to see Mrs. Gomer for a pass to attend, so she can get an accurate head count & know who is supposed to be where. • MONDAYS, Juniors & Seniors Get eMails: Class of 2018 & C/O2017 are receiving an email in their school gmail account every Monday to remind them about upcoming visits that week. They received one yesterday, & she also shared with them her College Visits Google Slides which features upcoming colleges & has a snapshot of the college e.g. total cost of attendance, location, size, student/faculty ratio etc.

• FAFSA= Free Application for Federal Student Aid & FSA ID:

In order to submit a FAFSA both the student & parent will need a FSA ID, which consists of a user-created username & password. This allows users to electronically access personal information on Federal Student Aid Web sites as well as electronically sign a FAFSA. This needs to be completed prior to filling out the FAFSA, & should be done prior to October 1, 2016. Create it now! Clink on the link at <u>https://fsaid.ed.gov/</u> (How-to-complete-a-FAFSA meeting for parents of college-bound seniors, will be scheduled, but parents & seniors will need to create a FSA ID.)

• UH Manoa - Manoa Experience, Sun, Nov. 6 at Maui Beach Hotel, 4-6pm:

UH Manoa will be hosting an "open house" event at the Maui Beach Hotel on Sun, Nov. 6 from 4-6pm to discuss the opportunities on the Manoa campus; attendees will also have the opportunity to meet with current UH Manoa students & staff, refreshments will be provided & parking is free.

• Schatz Seniors High School Internship Program is open to students statewide. The program is actually more of an externship, since the program is designed to take place during non-school hours. The time commitment is around 2-3 hrs a week. Students will work with other interns across the state, as well as their staff, on outreach & community events. They will also look at issues of interest & discuss policy. They meet via video-conference once a week & then attend evening or weekend events as they come up. This applies to our neighbor island interns as well. They will be working with their outreach staff on each of the islands. They will have all the interns together for an all day orientation in the fall & an all day session in April. Both will take place on a Friday, so interns would have to miss school then. Neighbor island interns are reimbursed for the airfare. Other than these two Fridays, the interns will not miss any class time. Their goal is to introduce our high school interns to the U.S. Senate offices, our outreach and policy work, college internships, & support our young leaders in Hawaii.

The Census Verification forms were individually printed with your demographics on it & given to your teen on Th, August 25. If your child lost it, you will need to come in to the Registrar's office to get another or she can print another & give it to your child.

Forms are due by TOMORROW, Th, Sept. 1, 2016. Late forms will result in delayed access to Infinite Campus, which will be your online access to your child's grades.
