Boo't be a fool in school!

WHAT HAPPENS IF... I assault another student or adult?

- Assault means...you intentionally, knowingly, or recklessly caused serious bodily injury or bodily injury to another person with or without a dangerous instrument.
- Assault is a Class A offense which is unlawful conduct for which you can be arrested and/or suspended from school.

WHAT HAPPENS IF... I bring my BB gun to school?

- A BB gun, an air gun, in addition to starter guns, shotguns, or cross bows along with explosives, or any weapon which will readily expel a projectile are considered violations of the Hawaii Gun Free Act.
- This means that you <u>shall be excluded</u> from attending school for not less than one calendar year. Only the Superintendent of Education, on a case-by-case basis, may modify the exclusion.

WHAT HAPPENS IF... my friend gives me a pack of marijuana and I have it in my pocket, but don't use it?

 You may be suspended up to 92 days. The Zero Tolerance policy states that any child who possesses, sells or uses illicit drugs while attending school may be suspended as determined by the principal and approved by the Complex Area Superintendent.

WHAT HAPPENS IF... I bring a look-alike gun to school?

You could be arrested for "harassment", a Class B offense.
Displaying or possessing a "look-alike" gun or weapon is listed under one of the definitions for harassment, unlawful conduct.

WHAT HAPPENS IF... I call my friend a "fag"?

 You may be charged with harassment as it means a person acts with the intent to harass, bully, annoy or alarm another individual.
