## OPT-OUT FORM

for non-disclosure of a secondary school  
student's name, address, and telephone  
listing to military recruiters

*The No Child Left Behind Act of 2001 requires school districts to release the names, addresses, and telephone listings of secondary school students to military recruiters upon their request **unless** the students or their parents request that the students' contact information not be released without prior written parental consent. Hawaii Department of Education telephone listings include unlisted numbers. NCLB requires school districts to inform the secondary students' parents of their right to opt out.*

**If this form is completed, signed, and returned to the student's school**, the school and school district shall not release the student's name, address, and telephone listing to military recruiters without prior written parental consent.

**This form can be completed and signed by EITHER the secondary school student OR the student's parent or legal guardian.**
