
Freshman admission requirements:

- Cumulative GPA has increased to a preferred 3.00
- Seniors with a cumulative GPA of 3.00 or higher are no longer required to submit ACT or SAT scores.
- Students with a cumulative GPA below 3.00 as well as students who wish to receive consideration for designated academic scholarships, apply to their Honors Programs, or participate in athletics are required to provide scores.
- One letter of recommendation from a teacher or counselor who can address the student's academic preparation and future success at WOU.



 Sign Up for Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery (ASVAB) Test, Wed, Dec. 7, 8am in F204: The ASVAB is the most widely used multiple-aptitude test battery. This free test measures a student's strengths, weaknesses, & potential for future success. It also can provide career information for various civilian & military occupations & is an

indicator for success in future endeavors whether a teen chooses college, vocational school, or a military career. ASVAB results are NOT released to recruiters automatically. Students may sign up with College & Career Counselor, Mrs. (Gomer) Kovacic in F-204.
