**6:30pm at the lao Theater:**

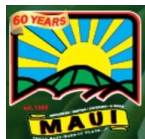

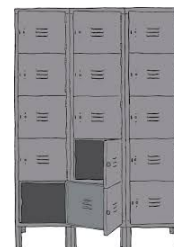
